KINDY IS A DEADLY CHOICE

RAIN STICK SENSORY BOTTLES

Materials needed:

- Empty, clean bottles
- Sticks from the garden
- Assorted seeds from the garden
- Beans
- Small Rocks
- Scoops
- Funnels





Method:

- 1. Place sticks of different lengths in the bottles
- 2. Add a variety of the other items you have gathered
- 3. Seal the lid tightly, use sticky tape if needed.

QUIET READING

Materials needed:

- Reading/picture books
- Comfy spot to sit
- Pillows
- Blankets





Method:

- 1. Find your bubs favourite book at home.
- 2. Search for the comfiest place in the house.
- 3. Sit with bub close to your body and begin story telling.
- 4. Allow Jarjums to explore the books, pages and allow them the opportunity to read themselves.

This is a deadly way to engage with your children, engage in literacy & teaching your Jarjums the importance or storytelling and reading.

CE PANTING

Materials needed:

- Food colouring
- Ice trays
- Paddle pop sticks
- Paper



- 1. Add a tiny drop of food colouring in the individual cubes in the ice tray and mix well with water.
- 2. Do this with all colours.
- 3. Place popsicle sticks in the individual cubes in the tray and then place in the freezer.
- 4. Freeze for about 4 to 6 hours or overnight

- 5. Pull on the sticks to remove from the tray
- 6. This is great for outside on the cement or grass.
- 7. Hold the wooden sticks to paint with on the paper









MAKING PLAYDOUGH & NATURE PLAY

Materials needed:

- Plain Flour
- Food Colouring (Not always needed)
- Salt
- Cream of Tartar (Method on the back of container)
- Vegetable Oil
- Natural materials from the garden/park/yard



- 1. Mix salt, food colouring, oil, cream of tartar and hot water into a bowl.
- 2. Once mixed well, add flour.
- 3. Stir until consistency thickens and turns into dough.
- 4. Once cooled, knead together.
- 5. Allow Jarjums to knead too.
- 6. Add playdough and natural materials to your area and allow Jarjums to explore.







COOKING FRIED RICE

Materials needed:

- Rice
- Soy Sauce
- Fresh or frozen vegetables
- Egg
- Bacon



Methods to be done by Jarjums

- 1. Wash hands thoroughly
- 2. Crack the eggs and whisk with a fork.
- Grate or cut fresh vegetables and cut bacon into small pieces.
- 4. Assist with stirring in a safe environment.
- 5. Wash rice


MATURE COLLAGE

Materials needed:

- Nature Items from your backyard or local land
- Glue (can also create collage without glue- to redo over and over!)
- Paint brush
- Cardboard- use something from your recycle bin



- 1. Cut out your cardboard in your desired shape
- 2. Crunch up your items to make small, or use them whole
- 3. Place glue on your cardboard
- 4. Decorate your cardboard shape using nature items









DYEING DRIED GOODS

Materials needed:

- Dried goods (pasta, chickpeas, beans, rice etc)
- Food colouring
- Vinegar or hand sanitiser
- Plastic zip lock bags
- Baking paper or Newspaper (something to dry the coloured goods on!)
- Baking trays or even just the ground outside.

KINDY IS A DEADLY CHOICE

- 1. Pour dried goods into large plastic bag.
- 2. Add a splash of vinegar or a squirt of hand sanitiser and a few drops of food dye into the baggie. The amount depends on how much pasta you are dying, but you really cannot go wrong- it is all fun and learning, like a science experiment keep adding if more is needed!
- 3. Close bag and shake and wiggle the dried goods around. Add more food colouring and vinegar or hand sanitiser if needed.
- 4. Let sit for a few minutes
- 5. Pour out on to a tray and spread out to dry. Outside in the sun is best as if it is not dried correctly, it can go mouldy




STORY TELLING STONES

Materials needed:

- Stones, rocks, or pebbles
- Permanent marker, paint pen or white out pen





Method:

- 1. Draw symbols, shapes, or pictures on your stones.
- 2. Link them to your culture or mob to tell a deadly story to celebrate you and your identity
- 3. Once you have finished your drawings use your stones for your story, let your mob have a turn to tell their own story too!

PRE-WRITING

Materials needed:

- Rice
- Flour
- Sand
- Dry Lentils
- Any dried goods can be used with this experience.
 You can even dye them different colours to make it more deadly!

- 1. Using a large baking tray or container, pour dried ingredients just covering the bottom.
- 2. For inspiration, you can write a letter at the top of the dried goods that your Jarjum can attempt to trace independently.














ICE PLAY

Materials needed:

- Room in your freezer
- Toys that can get wet, I.e., plastic animals or toy cars
- Containers
- Water





Method:

- Find some small sized toys that can get wet
- 2. Place toys in a container with space in between the toys.
- 3. Pour some water in, get your jarjums to help**
- 4. Place containers in freezer and wait overnight
- 5. Once frozen get your jarjums to decide how they want to crack the animals out. Could we melt them? Use our hands? Use a spoon? Or a hammer?

**If you have food colouring feel free to add a few drops during this step
